

# NOTICE OF INTENTION

## TO CONSIDER REPORT REGARDING BORROWING

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and *The Public Notice Policy Bylaw*, Bylaw No. 2020-28 of its intention to consider a report which would authorize the City to enter into a forgivable loan agreement in an amount not exceeding \$4,500,000 for the purpose of the purchase and renovation of land and buildings.

This matter will be considered by the **Executive Committee on May 29, 2024 at 9:00am and City Council at its meeting on Wednesday June 12, 2024 at 1:00 p.m.**
