
PUBLIC NOTICE:

ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT; DISCRETIONARY USE 535 E DOUGLAS AVENUE



DISCRETIONARY USE:



REASON: The Proponent is applying to rezone the Subject Property from I – Institutional Zone to: RL – Residential Low-Rise Zone

in order to pursue a 90-unit residential development at the Subject Property.

The Regina City Council will also be considering a Discretionary Use application for this proposed development, as the proposed 18 metre building height exceeds 15 metres, and because of a proposed day care operation.

INSPECTION: A copy of the proposed bylaw to amend the Zoning Bylaw (rezoning) will be available for examination on the City's website, commencing **Friday**, **June 7**, **2024**.

HEARING: City Council will consider the above noted applications at its meeting scheduled for **Tuesday**, **June 11**, **2024**, **at 1:00 p.m**. Citizens who want to address City Council may attend the meeting in-person or via teleconference.
