Overview	<i>I</i>
Proposal	The Applicant proposes to amend the Zoning Bylaw by rezoning 2322 Saint John Street (Subject Property) from RU – Residential Urban Zone to RL – Residential Low-Rise Zone, which supports the development of low-rise multi-unit building types.
	To understand land-use and development types potentially allowable in the RL Zone, please review Part 3C (TC.T2) of Chapter 3 of the City's Zoning Bylaw:

	The City is not reviewing an application for a proposed development at this time; however, the Applicant has indicated that they may pursue a 3-storey, 10.5 metre tall, residential building accommodating eight units, as shown in the attached images.
	The attached building images are included for information purposes, to illustrate a potential development scenario; however, do not form part of the rezoning application.
Additional Information	The Subject Property is located within the Heritage Neighbourhood, in close proximity to the General Hospital and 15 th Avenue.
	The RL Zone allows, as a Permitted Use (as-of-right), residential buildings up to 15 metres tall; however, the Proponent's current proposal is 10.5 metres. (note: for angled/ gabled roofs, height is measured to mid-point of roof)
	The Subject Property is not within an area subject to Neighbourhood Plan policy.
Process	
Review / Decision	Following the public and technical review process, which is currently underway, the Administration will submit a report to the Decision Authority, which will include a summary of the public comments, as well as Administration's recommendation.
	The Decision Authority respecting Zoning Bylaw amendments is the Regina City Council. Applications directed to Council will first be considered by the Regina Planning Commission (RPC) who will then provide a recommendation to Council.
	Both the RPC and Council meetings are open to the public; therefore, you may attend these meetings and view the deliberation, or speak directly to the RPC or Council. Please refer to the Application Review Process.

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
Appendix A-1 - Location





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Appendix A-2 - Zoning






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Appendix B-1 - Building Perspective





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
Appendix B-3 - Building Elevations
