

2024 Accessible Taxicab Licence Lottery

The City of Regina will host a random draw for seven Accessible Taxicab Owners Licences on Thursday, October 31, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. in the Darlene Hincks Committee Meeting Room at City Hall. The draw is open to the public.

The Lottery is open to any individual over the age of 18. Only one entry per individual is allowed.

Application forms must be filled out in person from October 21 to 25, (Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) at the Licensing service counter, Main Floor, City Hall, 2476 Victoria Avenue. Photo identification and a secondary piece of government-issued identification must be presented when applying. The lottery application fee is \$50. Corporate applications will not be accepted, and applications cannot be made on behalf of another person.

Successful applicants will be notified by registered mail. They must have a vehicle operating by February 1, 2025, and ensure they meet the regulations and requirements for operating an accessible taxicab in the Province of Saskatchewan and the City of Regina.
