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PUBLIC NOTICE: THE OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN AMENDMENTS – PROPOSED SASKATCHEWAN DRIVE CORRIDOR PLAN

Regina City Council intends to consider the following amendments to Design Regina: *The Official Community Plan, Bylaw No. 2013-48*.

- 1. Adopt a new OCP Part B.21 Saskatchewan Drive Corridor Plan; and
- Amend existing neighbourhood plans for the Downtown (Part B.4), Cathedral Area (Part B.6) and Heritage Neighbourhood (Core Area – Part B.8) to update outdated information and recognize Part B.21.

REASON – The Saskatchewan Drive Corridor Plan will provide a vision for transforming the stretch of Saskatchewan Drive from Winnipeg Street to McTavish Street to provide mobilty options for residents, an updated land use strategy and an enhanced public realm.

INSPECTION – A copy of the proposed bylaws will be available for examination on the City's website from Friday, August 16, 2024.

HEARING – City Council will hold a public hearing in relation to the proposed bylaws on Wednesday, August 21, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. Citizens who want to address City Council may attend the meeting via teleconference or in person.
