When to vote:

Regular Polls are open on Wednesday, November 13 from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Where to vote:

Do I need to register?

You can register ahead online until October 22. After that date, you can register in person at the polls. If you’ve recently moved, you may need to update your information.

What to Bring:

Ensure you have government-issued photo I.D. that shows your name and address; or two other pieces of acceptable I.D. View a list of acceptable I.D. at [Regina.ca/elections](https://regina.ca/elections)



Vote early:

Advance Polls run from November 1-4, including a drive-thru poll at City Hall. Eligible voters can vote at any of the advance polls! Visit [Regina.ca/elections](https://regina.ca/elections) to find an advance poll location near you.



Mail-in Ballots Available:

Apply online to mail in your ballot. Mail-in ballot kits are delivered mid-late October. Ballots must be received at the Election Office by 8 p.m. on November 13. Please leave enough time for mail to process!



Accessibility:

All poll locations are accessible. If you require assistance, please ask a poll clerk.



Free Transit:
