Applicant Terms and Conditions:

In accordance to the Bylaw and as per the Regina Fire Code;

- 1) No person shall start or suffer or permit an open air fire to be started or continued within the City unless the person has obtained a permit authorizing such a fire from the Fire Chief.
 - 2) An application for an open air fire permit shall be accompanied by payment of the applicable fee as established by Schedule "A" to this Bylaw.
- Application must be received by Regina Fire & Protective Services no later than 2 business days prior to the date of proposed fire.
 - ***It is the responsibility of the applicant to notify Regina Fire Dispatch at 306-777-7846 one half hour before and after burning.***
 - Measures to consider for preventing unwanted fire spread include; sufficient clearance between the fire and adjacent buildings, combustibles, the size and height of combustibles to be burned, the prevailing meteorological conditions, fire control measures such as extinguishers, hoses and water tanks, and if a receptacle is used, the design of the receptacle.
 - It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that smoke, fumes or other matter do not cause a nuisance to others or the fire must be extinguished.
 - Burning of any materials which may be hazardous, requires the additional approval from Saskatchewan Environment and The City of Regina, Infrastructure and Land Use.
 - The fire must be supervised at all times.
