Special Events

Events are planned to remember loved ones on special occasions:

- Mother's Day 2nd Sunday in May. Complimentary carnations for mothers' memorials will be available at the Cemetery Administration Office.
- Father's Day 3rd Sunday in June. Complimentary carnations for fathers' memorials will be available at the Cemetery Administration Office.
- Remembrance Day On November 11, visit the Field of Honour to place a flower in honour of a veteran.
- Tree of Memories From December 1 to January 15, people are invited to take part in the annual tradition
 of placing an ornament on the Tree of Memories in honour of a loved one. Visit the Riverside Memorial
 Cemetery during daylight hours to place your ornament on the tree. Remember that winter weather
 conditions can be harsh on ornaments. Retrieve your ornament by January 15 if you wish to keep it.
- Special Occasions for Families Family members and friends wishing to commemorate a significant date in the life of their loved one, by placing flowers or personal items, should inform the Cemetery Administration Office prior to placement to help ensure they are not disturbed during this time.
